Dear Members,

After taking proactive steps yesterday to curb the spread of COVID-19, as the Clovelly Country Club community, our President's address last night has forced us to enter a lockdown process in line with the Disaster Management Act.

Over the coming days the operations across all departments will be scaled down and reduced where possible to allow us to achieve a full state of secure lockdown by Thursday, 26th March 2020. What this means is the following:

- Golf will continue to operate over the next two days, with limited fields.
- There will only be a morning field on Thursday, from 07h00 – 09h00, and we ask that all these players vacate the premises by 14h00. This is to allow us to complete all necessary tasks and afford staff time to return safely to their homes before the lockdown is implemented.
- We ask that all members who may be playing golf or visiting the Club over the coming days remove all their valuables (including clubs) from the bag room and their personal lockers. We would prefer that these items are stored at your own premises.
- Halfway will remain as a "Grab & Go" offering for this period with limited seating to promote social spacing (no alcohol will be served).
- The Bar and Restaurant areas remain closed. Access is restricted as these areas have been sterilised and are being used as a storage facility.

ALL GOLF AND CLUB FACILITIES WILL BE OFF LIMITS FROM 14H00 ON THURSDAY 26TH MARCH 2020 UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE. ANY PERSON FOUND TO BE IN VIOLATION OF THE DISASTER MANAGEMENT ACT AND ITS PROHIBITIONS WILL BE REPORTED TO THE NECESSARY AUTHORITIES.

I can only reiterate that this may only be the beginning. Together, through calm and rational approach, we can overcome any obstacles which are thrown our way over the coming weeks and months. It will take hard work, understanding, passion and dedication. Fortunately, these are areas where Clovelly does not fall short.

We would like to assure all the Members of Clovelly Country Club that Management, Staff, the Committees and Governing Body Members have been, and will continue to work tirelessly, albeit remotely from home. We will ensure that Clovelly and all that it stands for is sustained now and for years to come.
